BENI DI BATASIOLO- Piedmont

White Wine

Batasiolo Gavi Del Comune Di Gavi Grantee, DOCG, 2003, 11.5%

It has a straw-yellow colour with greenish highlights and white flower bouquet. Well bodied, fresh and dry, it has an inviting, harmonious taste featuring bitter almonds. This wine is suited with antipasti, entrees of fish, fruits of the sea and white meat.

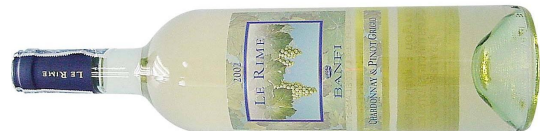

Extremely light and easy drinking, refreshing with fruity fragrance taste that pairs well with pasta, spicy foods and light meals.

Red Wine

Cantine Leonardo Da Vinci, Chianti, DOCG 2001

Clear, ruby-red in colour, with reasonable depth and legs indicating good structure. Perfumes of cherries and fresh red fruit, mingle with spicy, peppery notes. The wine is lively and fresh in the mouth, with soft, rounded tannins. Good intensity, attractive structure and fine, long length. Delicious with almost all kinds of starters and light meat dishes, both red and white. Perfect with pasta of all types.

Batasiolo Barbera D'Asti DOC Sabri', 2002, 13% (oak aged)

Ruby red colour with delicate bouquet and pleasantly fruity. Dry, well-balanced acidity and clean, smooth finish. Excellent with full-flavour dishes, meats and cheeses.
